**AGREED ORDER**

On this day the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners ("Board") considered the matter of the license of Prakash Bommala, D.V.M. ("Respondent").

Respondent, without admitting the truth of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set out in this Order, waived notice and hearing and agreed to the entry of this Order. Accordingly, the Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters this Order as set forth below.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent, Prakash Bommala, D.V.M., of Houston, Texas, holds Texas veterinary license #13093.
2. On November 3, 2020, a patient, cat, was seen by Respondent for inappetence and not defecating for seven days but drinking water and wobbly in the rear limbs.
3. On November 9, 2020, the patient was seen again by Respondent for posterior ataxia and was not eating or drinking. The Respondent prescribed medication and sent the cat home.
4. On November 20, 2020, the patient went to a specialty clinic that found the patient had Otitis and a vestibular disease.
5. The Respondent did not correctly diagnose the ear infection and instead stated that it was a kidney infection.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Pursuant to Texas Occupations Code, Chapter 801, the Board has jurisdiction over this matter. Respondent is required to comply with the provisions of the Veterinary Licensing Act, Chapter 801, Texas Occupations Code, and with the Board's Rules. Respondent received notice as required by law.
2. Respondent has violated Board Rule 573.22, Professional Standard of Care, of the Board's Rules of Professional Conduct.
3. Respondent has violated Section 801.402(6) of the Veterinary Licensing Act, Texas

Occupations Code, prohibiting engaging in practices or conduct that violates the board's rules of professional conduct.

4. Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under Texas Occupations Code, Sections 801.401(a), and 801.451.

5. Pursuant to Board Rule 575.25, Respondent's violations are Class C violations, and Respondent is subject to disciplinary action under that Rule.

#### **TERMS OF ORDER**

Now, therefore, the Board and Respondent agree to the following terms:

##### **1. CONTINUING EDUCATION**

- a. In addition to the annual continuing education required for license renewal, Respondent shall complete six (6) hours of continuing education in the area of feline medicine within six months of the date the Board approves this Order. Respondent shall submit documentation of the completed continuing education penalty and the required annual continuing education to the Board within six months of the date the Board approves this Order. Documentation shall be submitted directly to the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners at 1801 Congress Avenue, Suite 8.800, Austin, Texas 78701.

##### **2. ADHERENCE TO THE LAW AND BOARD RULES**

- a. Respondent shall abide by the Board's Rules of Professional Conduct, the Texas Veterinary Licensing Act, and the laws of the State of Texas and the United States.
- b. Respondent shall cooperate with the Board's attorneys, investigators, compliance officers and other employees and agents investigating Respondent's compliance with this Order.
- c. Failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Order, or with any other provisions of the Veterinary Licensing Act or the Board Rules, may result in further disciplinary action.


The effective date of the terms of this Order shall be the date it is adopted by the Board, unless stated otherwise.

**RESPONDENT'S CERTIFICATION**

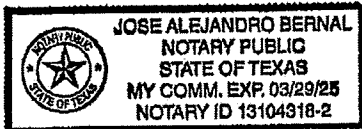




