NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT

This negotiated settlement has been entered by agreement between Dr. Robert Otis Colvin, his attorney Mr. Robert Kuehm, and the Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners staff in concurrence with the Board Secretary. It is presented to the Board as a recommendation only. If the Board elects to reject or amend this negotiated settlement the defendant, Dr. Colvin will be granted a continuance at his option.

Dr. Colvin does not contest the allegations set forth in the Complaint and agrees that, accordingly, the Board may treat the allegations of fact and law as true, which findings shall have the same force and effect as if evidence and argument were presented in support of the allegations, and based thereon, the Board found the allegations to be true. Respondent understands and intends that by so stating, he is not admitting the truth of the allegations, but is merely agreeing that the Board may enter an Order treating the allegations as true without the necessity of receiving evidence in support thereof.

SUMMARY OF CHARGES:

1. Dr. Colvin has violated Article 7465a, Section 7(b), of the Veterinary Licensing Act and Rule 30 of the Rules of Professional Conduct by failing to maintain records on Schedule II drugs.
2. Dr. Colvin has violated Rule 33 of the Rules of Professional Conduct by obtaining Schedule II drugs for self administration.
3. Dr. Colvin has violated Article 7465a, Section 14(b) of the Veterinary Licensing Act by addiction to drugs.

RECOMMENDED PENALTY:

1. License suspension for two years, all probated.

CONDITIONS:

1. Surrender Schedule II and IIN Controlled Substances Certificate (this has already been accomplished) to be reinstated at the discretion of the Board.
2. Participate in the after-care program as prescribed by the Hotel Dieu Treatment Program in conjunction with the TVMA Peer Assistance Program.
3. Submit quarterly progress reports to the Executive Secretary during the probation period. The report will include the results of a quarterly no-notice drug screening test conducted through the TVMA Peer Assistance Program.

4. Abide by Article 7465a, Veterinary Licensing Act and the Rules of Professional Conduct for the profession duly promulgated by the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners.

FINDINGS, CONCLUSIONS AND ORDERS OF THE BOARD

On the 29th day of January, 1987, the TEXAS STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS, being in regular meeting at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, such meeting being called for the purpose of hearing and considering the above numbered and entitled complaint as well as for consideration of other Board business, and the above entitled and numbered complaint having been previously scheduled for hearing and Defendant, the said ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M., having been duly notified and the following members of the TEXAS STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS being present, to-wit:

At 9:00 a.m., the appointed hour, the President of the Board, DR. ED B. AVERY ordered the case to proceed at which time it was ascertained that ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. and his legal counsel, ROBERT C. KUEHM, were present in person; the Board then proceeded to hear the evidence presented by the State, and by ROBERT KUEHM, Attorney for Dr. Colvin, and on the same day, January 29, 1987, all of the above members of said Board being present and participating, makes the following findings, to-wit:

FINDINGS OF FACT

I.

ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M., is a doctor of veterinary medicine, licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Texas under License 3389, 1986 Renewal Certificate Number 3498 with offices at Desert East Animal Hospital, 11635 Pellicano, El Paso, El Paso County, Texas.

II.

ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. received notice of this hearing on or about November 10, 1986.

III.

ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. was present before the Board and was represented by legal counsel.

IV.

Between the May, 1984 through June, 1986 DR. COLVIN, utilizing his DEA Controlled Substances Registration Number AC 2071277, ordered the following Schedule II Substances on DEA 222 Forms and has no records as to the disposition of these drugs:

From the period May, 1984 through June, 1986 DR. COLVIN, wrote the following Triplicate Prescriptions (Reg. No. K0031926) and has no records as to the disposition of the drugs:

VI.

For the period September 20, 1986 through October 17, 1986, ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. was admitted to the Hotel Dieu Treatment Center for treatment of chronic abuse and addiction to chemical substances.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.

The Board concludes that DR. COLVIN entered into a Negotiated Settlement and that he does not contest the allegations set forth in the

Complaint and agrees that, accordingly, the Board may treat the allegations of fact and law as true, which findings shall have the same force and effect as if evidence and argument were presented in support of the allegations and based thereon, the Board found the allegations to be true, Respondent understands and intends that by so stating, he is not admitting truth of the allegations, but is merely agreeing that the Board may enter an Order treating the allegations as true without the necessity of receiving evidence in support thereof.

ORDER

It is hereby ORDERED that Texas Veterinary License No. 3389, heretofore issued to ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. by the TEXAS STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS, be and the same is HEREBY SUSPENDED for a period of two (2) years, from the date this Order is received by the Defendant, PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the execution of this Order of Suspension be and it is HEREBY PROBATED upon the following conditions:

1. That Dr. Colvin surrender his Schedule II and IIN Controlled Substances Certificate to be reinstated at the discretion of the Board.
2. That Dr. Colvin participate in the after-care program as prescribed by the Hotel Dieu Treatment Program in conjunction with the TVMA Peer Assistance Program.
3. That Dr. Colvin submit quarterly progress reports to the Executive Secretary during the probation period. The report will include the results of a quarterly no-notice drug screening test conducted through the TVMA Peer Assistance Program. The first report is due April 1, 1987.
4. That Dr. Colvin abide by Article 7465a, Veterinary Licensing Act and the Rules of Professional Conduct for the profession duly promulgated by the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners.

The foregoing Findings and Orders of the Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners are ORDERED to be entered as the FINDINGS AND ORDERS of the Board, a quorum and a majority of the members of such Board being present and participating in such hearing, deliberations and decision, and such FINDINGS AND ORDERS are made on the 29th day January, 1987, in Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas.

The Secretary of the Board is hereby ordered to prepare the Board's Findings and Orders in appropriate form and submit to the members of the Board for their signatures and to mail a copy of same to the Respondent at his last known address.

COMPLAINT AFFIDAVIT FORM

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for Texas, on this day personally appeared ERNIE M. CARROLL, who after being duly sworn, did depose and say:

"I, ERNIE M. CARROLL, being an employee of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, did in the course of such employment, make certain investigations into the professional conduct of one DR. ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M., Desert East Animal Hospital, 11635 Pellicano, El Paso County, El Paso, Texas, Texas Veterinary License Number 3389, 1986 Renewal Certificate Number 3498, a practitioner of veterinary medicine in the State of Texas. As an employee of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, I, ERNIE M. CARROLL, do hereby present the following complaint against ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M., who is hereinafter called Respondent.

I.

Between the May, 1984 through June, 1986 DR. COLVIN, utilizing his DEA Controlled Substances Registration Number AC 2071277, ordered the following Schedule II Substances on DEA 222 Forms (See Exhibit A) and

Disposition of these drugs:

IV.

By acquiring the controlled substances outlined in paragraphs I and II and failing to maintain records on same, DR. ROBERT O. COLVIN has violated Rule 30 of the Rules of Professional Conduct which states in part:

"Texas veterinarians shall maintain at their place of business records of all drugs listed in Schedule II of 21 Code of Federal Regulation, Part 1300 to end, in their possession. These records shall be maintained for a minimum of five (5) years. The Board shall prescribe a form for keeping records of those Schedule II substances which shall contain the following information:

- A. Date of Acquisition
- B. Quantity Purchased
- C. Date Administered, Dispensed, or Prescribed
- D. Quantity Administered, Dispensed, or Prescribed
- E. Name of Client and Patient receiving the Drug(s)
- F. Diagnosis
- G. Balance on Hand"

V.

By writing the Triplicate Prescriptions listed in Paragraph II, for other than use in treating animals, DR. ROBERT OTIS COLVIN has violated Rule 33 of the Rules of Professional Conduct which states"

"It shall be unprofessional and a violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct for the veterinary profession for a veterinarian to prescribe, provide, obtain, order, administer, possess, dispense, give or deliver to or for any person, narcotic drugs, dangerous drugs, or any controlled substances that are not necessary or required for the care of animals, or where the use or possession of such drugs would promote addiction thereto. For purposes of the rule the term Narcotic Drugs, Dangerous Drugs, and Controlled Substances shall mean those which are defined and recognized as such by any law of the State of Texas or of the United States."

VIII.

ROBERT OTIS COLVIN, D.V.M. is a licensed veterinarian in the State of Texas, having received license number 3389 on August 3, 1973 from the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners. DR. COLVIN has renewed his license each year since its issuance and on February 20, 1986, he received renewal certificate number 3498.

IX

The Texas Veterinary Licensing Act, Article 7465a, Vernon's Annotated Texas Statutes, Section 14(b), (c) and (e) which states:

" . . . the Board may revoke or suspend a license, place a person whose license has been suspended on probation or reprimand a licensess, . . . if it finds that an applicant or licensee:

(b) is chronically or habitually intoxicated or is addicted to drugs; or

(c) has engaged in dishonest or illegal practices in or connected with the practice of veterinary medicine; or

(e) has engaged in practices or conduct in connection with the practice of veterinary medicine which are violative of the standards of professional conduct as duly promulgated by the Board in accordance with the law; or"

The foregoing complaint is submitted to the Secretary of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners on this the 4th day of November, 1986.

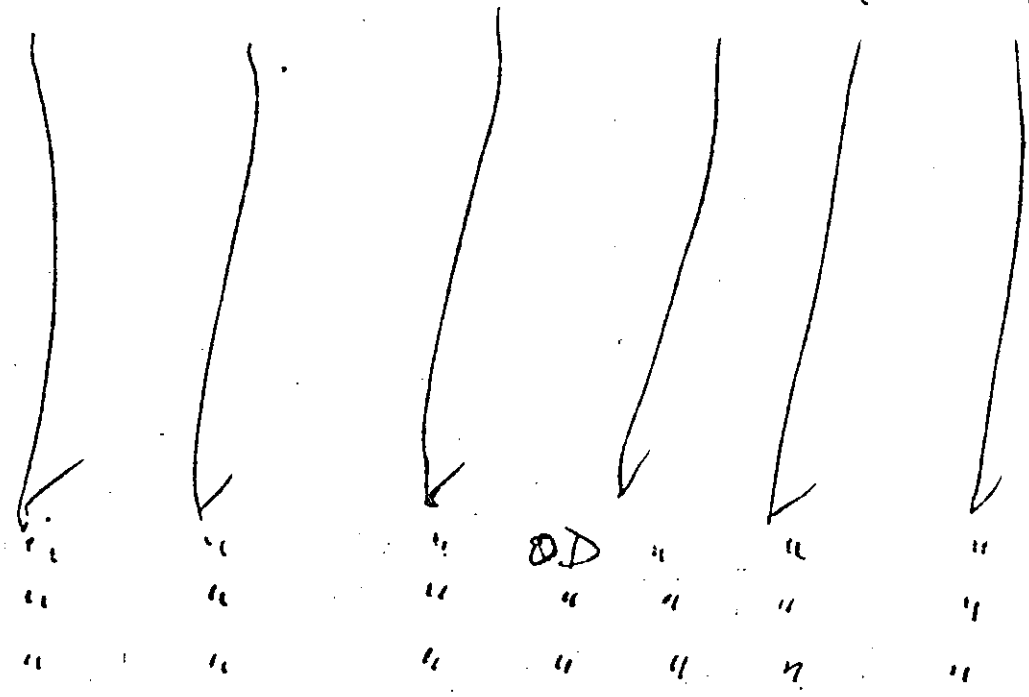

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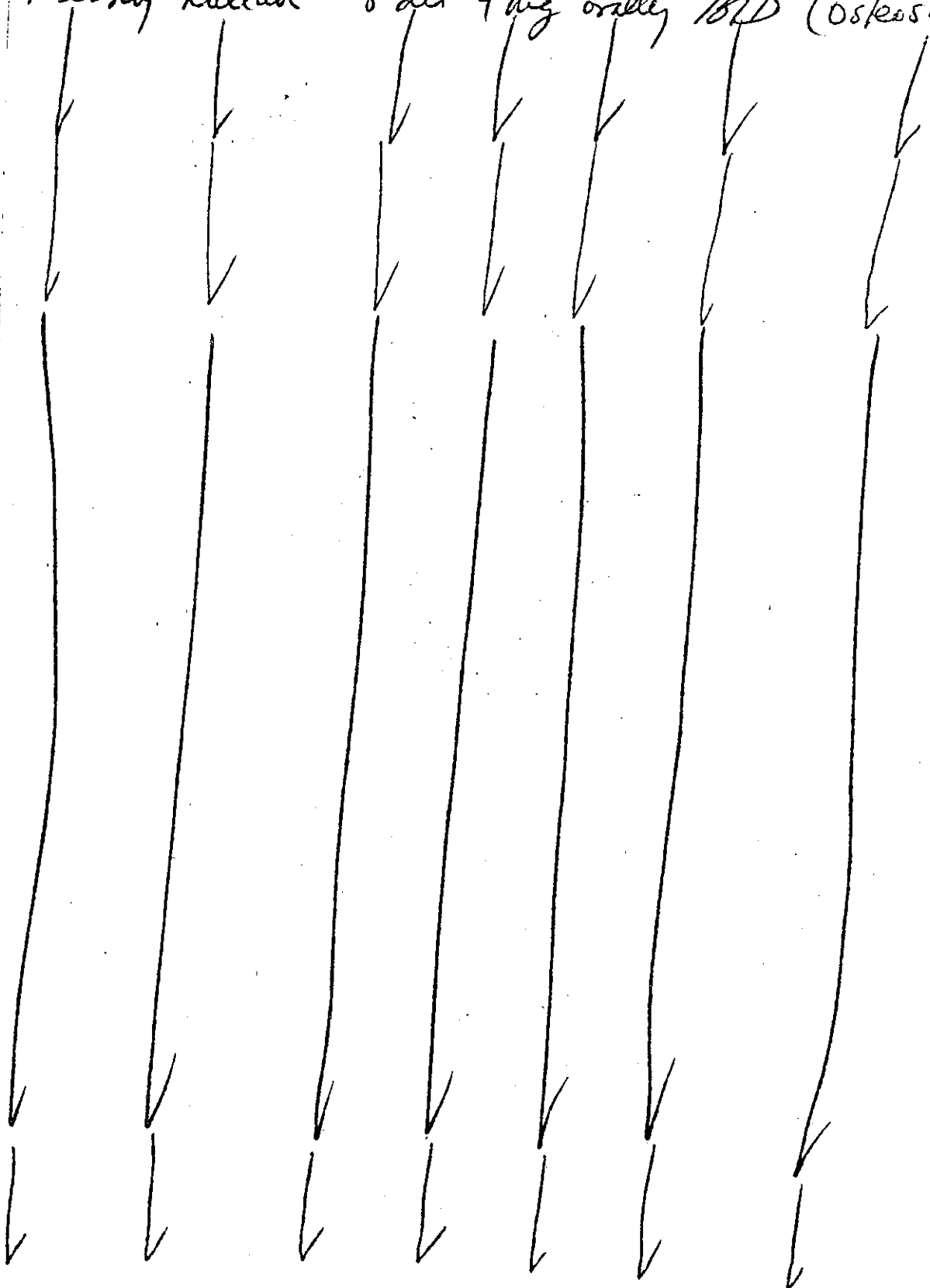

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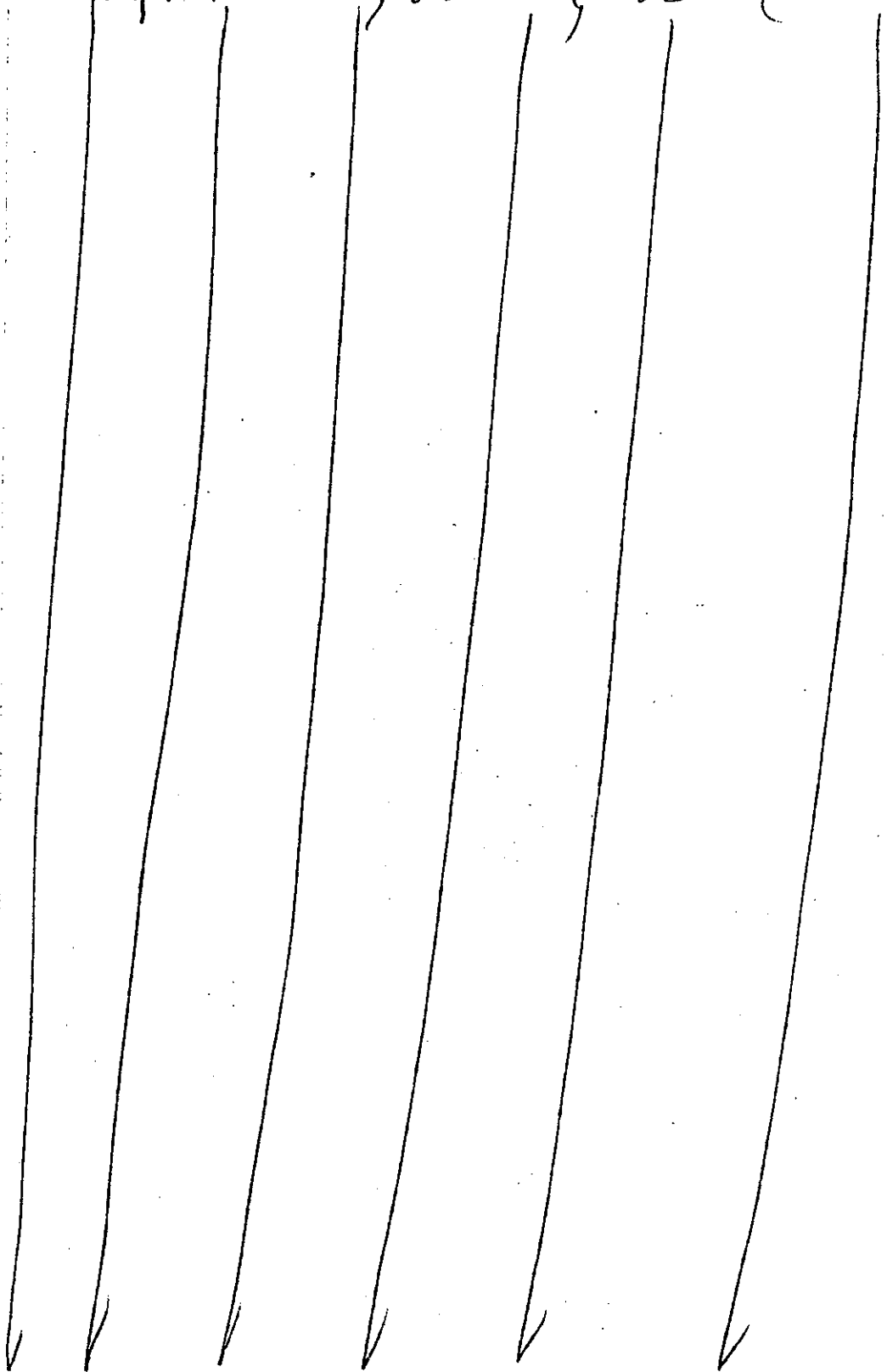
