

COMPLAINT AFFIDAVIT

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for Texas, on this day personally appeared MATTHEW WENDEL, who after being duly sworn, did depose and say:

On or about August 30, 1991, MATTHEW WENDEL, being an employee of the Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, did in the course of such employment, make certain investigations into the professional conduct of one RICKY COLEMAN ERWIN, D.V.M., Lady Lake Animal Hospital, P.O. Box 1540, Lady Lake, Florida, 32159, Texas Veterinary License Number 3251, 1992 Renewal Certificate Number 3108, licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Texas. As an employee of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, I, MATTHEW WENDEL, do hereby present the following complaint against RICKY COLEMAN ERWIN, D.V.M.

I.

On or about July 9, 1987, Ricky Coleman Erwin, D.V.M., was

convicted in Circuit Court, in and for Marion County, Florida, in case number 87-904-CF-A-W, of (Count 1) arson of an occupied structure; (Count 2) attempted arson of an unoccupied structure; (Count 3) arson of an unoccupied structure; (Count 4) criminal conspiracy to commit arson; (Count 5) criminal solicitation to commit arson, all first degree felonies. The structure which was burned down was a stable with attached living quarters. Twelve thoroughbred horses were also destroyed in the fire.

II.

On or about July 20, 1987, Ricky Coleman Erwin, D.V.M., was sentenced in the same court and case number described in paragraph 1, to four and one-half (4 1/2) years confinement in the Florida Department of Corrections, followed by fifteen (15) years of probation. He was also ordered to pay a fine of \$5,000.00 and make restitution.

III.

By having been convicted of a felony, Dr. Erwin has violated Section 14 (d) of the Veterinary Licensing Act, Article 7465a, V.A.C.S., which states, in part, that:

"...The Board may revoke or suspend a license, impose a civil penalty, place a person whose license has been suspended on probation, or reprimand a licensee...if it finds that...a licensee:

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(d) has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this or any other state of the United States or of the United States.

IV.

The Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners has grounds to take disciplinary action against Dr. Erwin's Veterinary License under the Texas Veterinary Licensing Act, V.A.C.S., Article 7465a, Section 14 which states in part:

ARTICLE 7465a, SECTION 14

". . . the Board may revoke or suspend a license, impose a civil penalty, place a person whose license has been suspended on probation, or reprimand a licensee . . . if it finds that a licensee:

(d) has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this or any other state of the United States or of the United States.

V.

The Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners has additional grounds to take disciplinary action against Dr. Erwin's Veterinary License under Tex. Rev. Civ. Stat. Ann. 6252-13C. This statute mandates that Dr. Erwin's license be revoked if it is proven to the Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners that Dr. Erwin has been convicted of a felony:

6252-13C Section 7(e)

Upon a licensee's felony conviction, felony probation revocation, revocation of parole, or revocation of mandatory supervision, his license shall be revoked.

The foregoing complaint is submitted to the Secretary of the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners on this the 24th day of June, 1992.

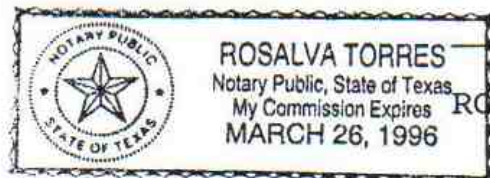
