



- a. Respondent's license shall be suspended April 4, 2022, with said suspension stayed and Respondent placed on probation for the entire period of the suspension.
- b. If Respondent does not timely and satisfactorily comply with any of the terms of this Modified Order, the Board may rescind Respondent's probation pursuant to Board Rule 575.36.

2. ADHERENCE TO THE LAW AND BOARD RULES

- a. Respondent shall abide by the Board's Rules of Professional Conduct, the Texas Veterinary Licensing Act, and the laws of the State of Texas and the United States.
- b. Respondent shall cooperate with the Board's attorneys, investigators, compliance officers and other employees and agents investigating Respondent's compliance with this Modified Order.
- c. Failure by Respondent to comply with the terms of this Modified Order, or with any other provisions of the Veterinary Licensing Act or the Board Rules, may result in further disciplinary action.

The effective date of the terms of this Modified Order shall be the date it is adopted by the Board, unless stated otherwise.

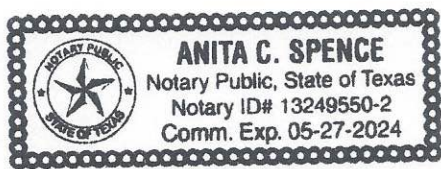
