

**TEXAS BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

**COMPLAINT NO. CP19-121, CP12-122 & CP22-256  
ORDER PERTAINING TO REVOCATION OF**

**LICENSE NO. 12095**

WHEREAS, the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners (Board) finds that on May 4th, 2022, TODD GLOVER, D.V.M., formerly of League City, Texas, License No. 12095, was convicted by the 56<sup>th</sup> District Court of Galveston County, Texas, of Engaging in Organized Crime, a 1<sup>st</sup> degree felony, and sentenced to confinement with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, under current law, TODD GLOVER, D.V.M., began his imprisonment upon the date of his sentencing; and

WHEREAS, Texas Attorney General Opinion No. GA-0064 states that under Section 53.021 of the Occupations Code, a license holder's license is revoked by operation of law upon the license holder's imprisonment following a felony conviction, felony community supervision revocation, revocation of parole, or revocation of mandatory supervision;


THEREFORE, the Board FINDS that:

1. License No. 12095 issued to TODD GLOVER, D.V.M., was automatically revoked by operation of law on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
2. TODD GLOVER, D.V.M., may apply for re-licensure in the same manner as a person applying for a new license and shall be subject to the requirements of Board Rule 575.22 relating to license reinstatement.

The Board ORDERS that:

A copy of this Order shall be mailed by first class mail to TODD GLOVER'S last known mailing address as reflected in the Board's records on this date, as well as to the mailing address provided by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
