AGREED ORDER

This agreed order has been entered into between Timothy W. Hawks, D.V.M. (Respondent) and Ron Allen, the Executive Director of the Texas State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners (Board), in concurrence with the Board Secretary. It is presented to the Board as a recommendation only.

Respondent understands that he is not admitting the truth of the allegations, but is merely agreeing that the Board may enter an Order treating the allegations as true without the necessity of receiving evidence in support thereof. Respondent does not contest the ^{24 and 27} ~~allegations~~ set forth in the Complaint, attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes, and agrees that: (1) the Board may treat the allegations of fact and law as true, and (2) the findings shall have the same force and effect as if evidence and argument were presented in support of the allegations.

The effective date of this order is the date the order is signed and entered by the Board.

RECOMMENDED DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

1. The Board ORDERS that Respondent receive an Official Reprimand.
2. Respondent agrees to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$600 payable within forty-five (45) days of the date the Board signs the order.

CONDITIONS:

1. Within 15 days of the date the Board signs this order, Respondent agrees to file written notification with the Board of the locations of his veterinary practice. This notice shall contain the address, city, dates and times of service of each location of practice. Respondent agrees to notify the Board of any variations from the schedule submitted. All notifications to the Board shall be in compliance with

Rule 573.70 of the Rules of Professional Conduct.

2. Respondent agrees to abide by the Rules of the Board, the Veterinary Licensing Act and the laws of the State of Texas and of the United States.

3. Any violation of this Agreed Order may result in further disciplinary action against Respondent.

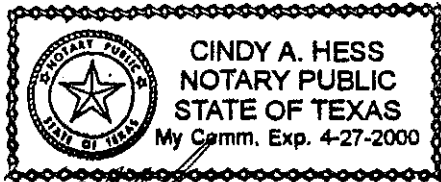
